### **GLENFARCLAS THE FAMILY CASKS**

Glenfarclas has been owned and managed by the Grant family since 1865, when on 8th June John Grant acquired the tenancy of Rechlerich Farm on the Ballindalloch Estate in Banffshire for £511.19s.0d. The distillery was granted its licence almost 30 years prior however, in 1836, utilising the fine soft water running off Ben Rinnes. Today, Glenfarclas is one of only a handful of distilleries to remain family-owned and managed having passed through six generations of Grant, all confusingly, or endearingly, named John or George.

A rich, highly age-worthy spirit is produced from the largest stills in Speyside, some of the last in Scotland still directly gas-fired. The house style is then developed during slow maturation on site in traditional earthenware-floored dunnage warehouses. The exclusive use of ex-Oloroso Sherry casks allows the unmistakeable fruitcake and spice characters to be imparted, slowly ensuring great balance and integration.

In 2007, Glenfarclas launched an ambitious collection of whiskies called the Family Casks: a series of 43 single-cask, vintage single malts, spanning some five decades. Thanks to the foresight of George S. Grant in the 1960s -who made the decision to lay down more stock – the range has continued to grow to the unrivalled collection we present here. George Grant describes the significant occasions people buy these bottles for
